Sheet 2 of 2 - System name and system designator number are different font format than shown on Sheet 1 of 2.

In fact, Sheet 2 prints with different margins than Sheet 1 and is smaller overall.

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Also - Sheet 2 of 2 - Uses the acronym "BLON". There is no glossary of terms in the 1995 guide, and a novice user may not know what this term represents.

Unless there is a glossary of terms added to the new guide, I recommend writing out full terminology for clarification.

Suggestion from my review of Brakemaster 350 drawings:

- 1) Show BLON on drawing,
 - 2) I noticed this quite a bit on several of the drawings: Use consistent dimensions between the specification and drawing pages, i.e. 378 {9600} system length on drawing and 9601 mm on specification,
 - 3) label dimensions on drawing, i.e. 378 inches,
 - 4) Use consistent units, don't have BLON in ft and meters, and then the system length in inches and mm,
 - 5) list FHWA acceptance letter number and NCHRP 350 TL on Specification page.
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
